WARNING! A cart equipped with this motor or private speed setting will increase the speed of the vehicle so that it will not conform to the speed criteria of the ANSI Z130.1 standard for golf cars safety and performance requirements. The user uses this product at their own risk.



STOP

Please review the following to be sure that you don't cause damage to your golf cart (i.e. batteries or electrical system.)

- **Check wheel lugs**. After your first few test drives in your custom cart and every few months, be sure to check the tightness of the wheel lugs to ensure they haven't loosened during use.
- Charge your cart daily when in use. Deep cycle golf cart batteries like to be cycled on the top 80% of their charge.
- **Water your batteries monthly**. Check your battery water level after the cart has been charged, ideally the water level should be a 1/4" 1/2" above the plates.
- **Do not over water your batteries**, this will lead to improper electrolyte ratio and bubbling over of your batteries while charging.
- Always store your cart fully charged.
- Always put your cart in tow mode when working in the battery compartment.
- Be sure battery nuts are tight and secure!
- Your cart is equipped with a regenerative braking system, you must always put your cart in tow mode if you are pushing or towing it.
- If the cart is **not being used for extended periods of time**, but you will still be around to charge it, then we suggest charging it once a month.

If you are uncertain about any procedures, refer to your owner's manual or contact SC Carts before proceeding.

QUICK MAINTENANCE TIPS

We are pleased to present you with an SC Carts Custom Golf cart! Your cart has been fully serviced and is ready to ride. The following are a couple tips to help ensure your cart performs its best for years to come! This is just an overview for more detailed information please refer to the owner's manual:

BATTERY MAINTENANCE TIPS:

WATERING:

- Check your water levels monthly!
- There should always be a minimum of a ¼" of water above the plates and approximately a maximum of a ½" of water above plates, you do not want to over water the batteries as it will dilute the electrolyte and potentially boil over while charging.
- Add water only after fully charging the battery pack BUT prior to charging, you must ensure there is water covering the plates. Keeping the water at the correct level after a full charge will prevent having to worry about the water level at a different state of charge.

CHARGING:

- Charge at every opportunity!
- Lead acid batteries like to be cycled, but do not like to be kept below 80% charge for any length of time. Periods of inactivity can be extremely harmful to lead acid batteries.
- If you use your cart for a short spurt and then park it there is no need to charge it, however if you use your cart for any length of time then it is recommended to charge the cart after each use and at the end of each day.
- When placing the cart into storage, it is important to ensure the batteries are
 completely charged and the cart is in the tow mode. During the storage period it is
 important to ensure you charge your cart once a month. If you are unable to charge
 the cart on a monthly basis, then one of our SC Carts battery maintainers is the best
 solution to ensure you protect the investment of your batteries.

WINDSHIELD MAINTENANCE TIPS:

We recommend using the soft blue Scott towels with an alcohol free or ammonia free foaming window cleaner. If there is excess dirt or dust on the windshield, prior to wiping the windshield, rinse it first with a hose or blow off the dirt with pressurized air.

WARRANTY

Used Golf Cart Limited Warranty Terms and Conditions

SC Carts provides that the golf cart purchased in this sale is delivered in a fully refurbished state. This golf cart is used and therefore will show signs of normal wear and tear for its age. This limited warranty is in respect to parts only is extended to the Original Purchaser for defects reported to SC Carts no later than the following warranty periods for the vehicle parts and components set forth below.

Part or Component	Warranty Period
FRAME	24 months
SUSPENSION - Steering gearbox, steering column, shocks and leaf springs	24 months
MAJOR ELECTRONICS - Electric motor, solid state speed controller and battery charger	24 months
DEEP CYCLE BATTERIES	12 months
PEDAL GROUP - Pedal assemblies, brake assemblies, brake cables and motor brake	24 months
SEATS - Seat bottom, seat back and hip restraints	24 months
other components - Canopy and canopy struts, Solenoid, limit switches, voltage regulator, F&R switch, and all other components or accessories installed by SC Carts	24 months

The warranty period for all parts and components of the vehicle shall commence on the date of delivery to the Purchaser's location or the date on which the vehicle is placed in Purchaser-requested storage. Parts repaired or replaced under this limited warranty are warranted for the remainder of the length of the part or component warranty period.

Exclusion: Specifically **EXCLUDED** from this Limited Warranty are:

- routine maintenance items, normal wear and tear, cosmetic deterioration or electrical component damage as a result of fluctuations in electric current;
- damage or deterioration of a vehicle, part or battery charger resulting from inadequate maintenance, neglect, abuse, accident or collision;
- damage resulting from installation or use of parts or accessories not approved by SC Carts;
- repairs made by other than SC Carts without prior consent from SC Carts;
- damage or loss resulting from acts of nature, vandalism, theft or other events over which SC Carts has no control.
